



Title of Training:

Child Development (Assessment & Work with Children)

Brief description

In this training we explore the different concepts relevant for child development (including abnormal development). We will introduce a model of resilience and risk and protective factors as a way of assessing children's situations, and how to use that for developing appropriate interventions. We will also look at ways how cooperation between different stakeholders in child care can be improved to provide better care. Together with the participants we will design action oriented care plans, that can be used in their daily practice.

Duration: 3 days (depending on the needs and wishes, the training can be extended to 5 days)

Course aims and objectives:

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Use the resilience model to assess children's situation
- Develop appropriate interventions
- Read and use non-verbal communication with children
- Recognize problems in children's behavior

Course content:

- Child development, concepts
- Normal and abnormal child development
- Resilience model
- Child abuse (recognizing and interventions)
- Non-verbal communication in children
- Intersession (peer group supervision)
- Care planning
